




PASTICCERIA MARTESANA

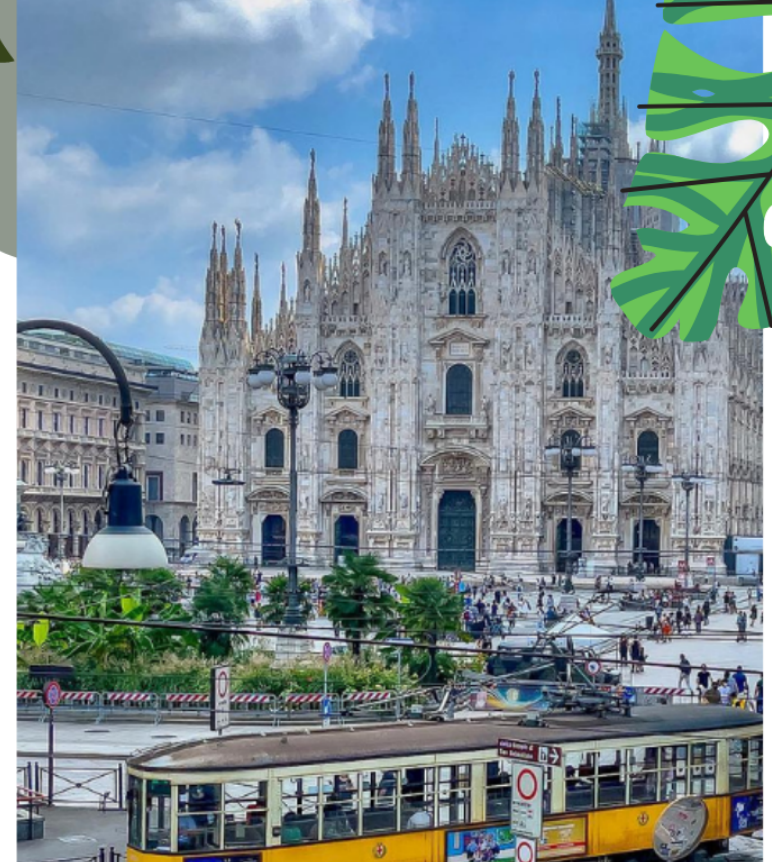


About The city

Main economic and financial center of the Italian peninsula, Milan guided its industrial development, forming the "Industrial Triangle" with Turin and Genoa, especially during the years of the economic boom when industrial and urban development also involved the neighboring cities, creating the vast metropolitan area of Milan.



In the cultural sphere, Milan has become the main Italian publishing center and is at the top of the world music circuit thanks to the opera season of the Teatro alla Scala and its long operatic tradition. Milan is also one of the main European exhibition centers and industrial design, and is considered one of the four world capitals of fashion.

About the museum

1. With a total of 50,000m² it is the largest technical-scientific museum in Italy and one of the largest in Europe.
2. It has the largest collection in the world of machine models based on drawings by Leonardo da Vinci. It is visited by over 500,000 people a year.

Tiello offers a typical Neapolitan meal, the cuzzatiello. In fact, a few steps from the cathedral you can eat your meal for a few euros. I recommend it to anyone who wants to eat a classic Neapolitan for a few pennies, especially to young people with few money in their pockets

Miscusi is an original format born a few steps from Piazza Cinque Giornate, which focuses on the most classic of Italian cuisine dishes, fresh pasta. 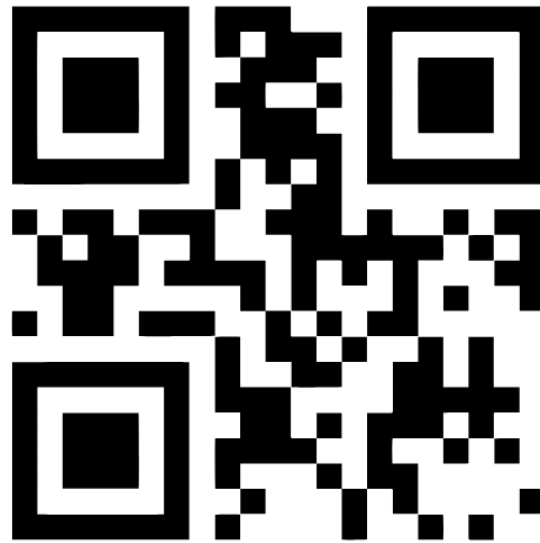
